RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER

APPROVING AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 COPPERMINE CHAPTER CARRYOVER FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$706,434.33 FOR COPPERMINE CHAPTER AS THE CARRYOVER BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023.

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), and 11 N.N.C., Section 10, The Coppermine Chapter is duly recognized and certified Chapter of The Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Part 1, Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to Title 26, N.N.C., Section 1(B), The Coppermine Chapter is vested the governmental authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. At the end of each fiscal year The Coppermine Chapter finds it necessary to make amendments to the previous annual Fiscal Year Navajo Nation Comprehensive Budget to Carryover remaining budget amounts to continue to implement its goals and objectives; and
4. All proposed expenditures of Chapter funds must be contained in a duly-approved Chapter Budget and expended pursuant to the Chapter's written Policies and Procedures and consistent with the applicable Navajo Nation law; and
5. The remaining balance of the Coppermine Chapter FY 2022 Budget is \$706,434.33 this amount will be carried over into FY 2023 Operating Budget for Coppermine Chapter.





WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 3, and 11 N.N.C., Section 10 the Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Chapter 1, Navajo Nation Chapters, Section 1. Amendment, (B) (1) (2), the Navajo Nation Council delegates to Chapter government authority with respect to local matter consistent with Navajo Law, including custom and tradition allows chapter to make decisions to govern with responsibility and accountability to community membership; and
3. Navajo Tribal Council CJ-21-21-53 established the Navajo Higher Education Scholarship Fund and provide for its administration through the Advisory Committee of Navajo Tribal Council Resolution ACA-63-53 which adopted the rules and regulations for the operation of the funds; and
4. The Coppermine Chapter has established so that each student requesting chapter scholarship financial assistance will be given in the amount of \$500.00 from the Chapter Scholarship Fund for financial assistance; and
5. Each student will be required to fill out the Chapter Scholarship Application and follow its guidelines and stipulation which requires students to turn in their official final grades before a check is issued out; and




