RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION

Approving and Adopting the Fiscal Year 2023 "General Fund", Special Revenue Fund- Internal" Budget in the amount of \$266,329.00

WHEREAS:

1. The Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized and certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation government, pursuant to 26 NNC Section 3, 11 N.N.C., Part 1 Section 10: and
2. Pursuant to the title 26, N.N.C., Section 1 (B), The Coppermine Chapter is vested the governmental authority to review all matters affecting the Community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. The Navajo Nation Appropriations Act, 12 N.N.C., §§ 800 *et seq.*, is the primary Navajo Nation law which authorized the process of developing and implementing the annual Navajo Nation comprehensive budget. The Appropriations Act states that the Navajo Nation government has a fiduciary responsibility to:
 - Account for public funds.
 - Manage finances wisely.
 - Plan for the adequate funding of services desired by the Navajo people, including the provision and Maintenance of public facilities.
4. All proposed expenditures of Chapter funds must be contained in a duly-approved Chapter Budget and expended Pursuant to the Chapter's written Policies and procedures and consistent with applicable Navajo Nation law; and
5. Below is the SUMMARY OF BUDGET for the Chapter Budget which will be incorporated into FY 2023 operating budget with the approval of the Annual Navajo Nation Budget by the Navajo Nation Council.

RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION

REQUESTING THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS (BIA) BRANCH OF ROADS AND THE NAVAJO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NDOT) TO REPAIR SEVERE RAIN STORM DAMAGE TO NR 6210 NEAR PORCUPINE MESA AREA BY UTILIZING A BULLDOZER TO REMOVE HEAVY SAND ACCUMULATION AND TO RIP EXPOSED ROCK OUTCROPPING TO IMPROVE SAFE AND CONVENIENT TRAVEL FOR CHAPTER RESIDENTS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

WHEREAS:

1. The Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation government pursuant to Title 26 N.N.C. Section 3; 11 N.N.C., Part 1 Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to Title 26, N.N.C., Section 1 (B), The Coppermine Chapter is vested with governmental authority to review all matters affecting the Community to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. An intergovernmental agreement and understanding exists for joint partnership and obligations for road maintenance and improvements on system roads within Coppermine Chapter; and
4. NR 6210 is heavily used by western Coppermine residents, health and welfare agencies, emergency vehicles and the safe transportation of students of the area; and
5. A heavy rainstorm in late August washed out the western side of Porcupine Mesa resulting in heavy accumulation of sand and exposing rock outcroppings which a motor grader can not adequately make passable; and
6. Under these circumstances, the only heavy equipment that can improve the conditions will be a bull dozer with the assistance of a frontend loader. The rock outcroppings can be done by a ripping operation.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOVED THAT;




