LEGISLATION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER LOCAL GOVERNMENT

REQUESTING THE SUPPORT AND APPROVAL OF THE NAVAJO NATION FOR THE RENEWAL OF A LEASE FOR A WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER IN THE COMMUNITY OF COPPERMINE LOCAL GOVERNMENT, RECOMMENDING AND APPROVING THE REINSTATED LEASE FOR A COMMUNICATION FACILITY AND RIGHT-OF-WAY IN NAVAJO TRIBAL TRUST LANDS SITUATED WITHIN T38N, R7E, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA 86040

WHEREAS:

The Coppermine Chapter is a certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation established and recognized by the Navajo Nation Council as a foundation of the Navajo Nation government vested with the authority to plan and implement projects in the best interest of the community. See generally N.N.C. Subsection 4021 et seq. and 26 N.N.C. § 103; and

Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 102 (a), the Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation; and

By Resolution CAP-34-98, the Navajo Nation Council approved the "Local Governance Act" wherein the Navajo Nation Council delegated governmental authority to the Chapters of the Navajo Nation to address matters of local concern with Navajo law, custom, and tradition; and

Verizon Wireless (VAW) LLC is seeking to renew the lease of a 177.7' self-support lattice telecommunications tower that will provide wireless communications and wireless broadband for the community of the Coppermine Chapter; and

The coordinates for the location of the wireless telecommunications tower on the Coppermine Chapter property is 36.6978511°N, -111.6302536°W (see attached Exhibit A for details), and

Verizon Wireless (VAW) LLC shall bear the sole expense and responsibility for all installation, removal, maintenance, or work of any kind performed; Ensure all work to be performed is performed by Verizon Wireless (VAW) LLC personnel or escorted authorized licensed contractor; Be responsible for providing quality control by means of physical inspections, preventative maintenance, repairs, and other testing to ensure the site meets any applicable regulatory requirements; Provide copies of as-built drawings upon request; Maintain valid and up to date FCC and/or FAA licensing for equipment housed in or mounted on the communication shelter or tower.

NOW, THEREFORE BE-IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Coppermine Chapter supports and approves a land withdrawal to Verizon Wireless (VAW) LLC for the lease renewal of a wireless telecommunications tower and equipment and an access and utility corridor within the Coppermine Local Government.

THENCE NORTH 08' 21' 07" EAST, 40.00 FEET;

THENCE SOUTH 81' 38' 53" EAST, 56.00 FEET;

THENCE SOUTH 08' 21' 07" WEST, 40.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
