RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION

SUPPORTING AND REQUESTING THE NAVAJO NATION TO THE TRIBAL UTILITY AUTHORITY TO ATTACH TO AN EXISTING ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION LINE, OPERATE, AND MAINTAIN A FIBER OPTIC CABLE INSTALLATION WITHIN THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER FOR EXPANDING AND ENHANCING COMMUNICATION SERVICES, AND REQUESTING THE NAVAJO NATION TELECOMMUNICATIONS REGULATORY COMMITTEE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT THIS FIBER OPTIC LINE.

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. §§ 3(A), the Coppermine Chapter is a certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation Government as listed at 11 N.N.C. ss 1 et seq., as amended, and possesses the authority and responsibility to promote local projects that benefit the local community and its economic development: and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. §§ 1 (B), the Coppermine Chapter is vested with authority to review all matters affecting the community and make appropriate recommendations to the Navajo Nation, Federal, State and Local Agencies for appropriate actions, and is also empowered by the Navajo Nation Council to review all matters affecting the local community and to make favorable decisions in the best interest of all the community to protect and promote the general health, safety and welfare of the Chapter's membership and all Navajos.
3. Coppermine Chapter is requesting the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority to construct attach, operate, and maintain a fiber optic cable to be extended to Coppermine Chapter by attaching to the existing electric distribution powerline. (See attached map).
4. Coppermine Chapter is also requesting the Navajo Nation's Telecommunications Regulatory Committee, to consider and appropriate funds to

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED THAT:

1. The Coppermine Chapter is requesting the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority to attach a fiber optic cable to an existing electric distribution powerline to be extended to the Coppermine Chapter and the community, and to operate, and maintain the fiber optic cable.
2. Coppermine Chapter is also requesting the Navajo Nation's Telecommunications Regulatory Committee, to consider and appropriate funds to construct this needed fiber optic line.

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 3, and 11 N.N.C., Section 10 the Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Chapter 1, Navajo Nation Chapters, Section 1. Amendment, (B) (1) (2), the Navajo Nation Council delegates to Chapter government authority with respect to local matter consistent with Navajo Law, including custom and tradition allows chapter to make decisions to govern with responsibility and accountability to community membership; and
3. Navajo Tribal Council CJ-21-21-53 established the Navajo Higher Education Scholarship Fund and provide for its administration through the Advisory Committee of Navajo Tribal Council Resolution ACA-63-53 which adopted the rules and regulations for the operation of the funds; and
4. The Coppermine Chapter has established so that each student requesting chapter scholarship financial assistance will be given in the amount of \$500.00 from the Chapter Scholarship Fund for financial assistance; and
5. Each student will be required to fill out the Chapter Scholarship Application and follow its guidelines and stipulation which requires students to turn in their official final grades before a check is issued out; and






