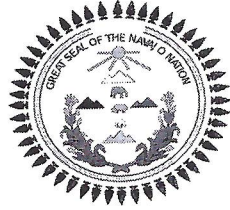

RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER

CO 02-034-20

THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER HEREBY APPROVES AND SUPPORTS THE SALES TAX REVENUE BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$67,625.00 RECEIVED FROM THE NAVAJO NATION NET REVENUES GENERATED BY TAXATION AND BUDGETED FOR GOVERNMENTAL EXPENDITURES FOR COPPERMINE CHAPTER.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), and 11 N.N.C., Section 10, the Coppermine Chapter is duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Part 1, Section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to the Title 26, NNC, Section 1 (B), The Coppermine Chapter is vested the governmental authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- 3. Pursuant to Resolution CO-84-01, the Navajo Nation Council approved the Navajo Nation Sales Tax and pursuant to Section 620 ( C ) of that Tax, 100% of the net revenue generated from retail establishments where no governance-certified chapter exists, shall be deposited in a trust fund and distributed pursuant to a plan of operation developed by the Office of Navajo Government Development and approved by the Budget and Finance Committee; and
- 4. The Budget and Finance Committee has determined that the Navajo Nation owes a higher duty of care to the chapters and the taxpayers to ensure the revenues generated by taxation, are adequately accounted for as well as expanded for infrastructure and economic development and governmental purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED THAT:

The Coppermine Chapter hereby approves and supports the Sales Tax Revenue Budget in the amount of \$67,625.00 received from the Navajo Nation net revenues generated by taxation and budgeted for governmental expenditures for Coppermine Chapter.

THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER APPROVES AND ADOPTS THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 UNHEALTHY FOOD TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,861.00 RECEIVED FROM THE NAVAJO NATION FROM ITS TAXES ON UNHEALTHY FOOD AND BUDGETED TO BE USED TO PAY FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), and 11 N.N.C., Section 10, the Coppermine Chapter is duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Part 1, Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to the Title 26, NNC, Section 1 (B), The Coppermine Chapter is vested the governmental authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. The Fiscal Year 2020 Unheathly Food Tax Revenues will be used to purchase building materials for infrastructure development to benefit community members. The Navajo Nation approves Unhealthy Food Tax Distribution Plan to chapters and establishes procedures to use and to account for net tax revenues in accordance with Tribal Law.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED THAT:

The Coppermine Chapter approves and adopts the Fiscal Year 2020 Unhealthy Food Tax in the amount of \$14,861.00 received from the Navajo Nation from its taxes on Unhealthy Food and budgeted to be used to pay for Infrastructure Development.
