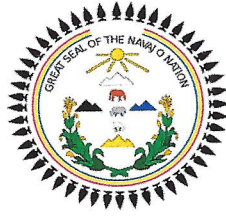

RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER

CO-09-0 -20

APPROVING THE FY 2021 GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION FUNDING BY THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL FROM THE GENERAL FUND REVENUE PROJECTION FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$260,173.00) APPROPRIATION FOR FY 2021 COPPERMINE CHAPTER GENERAL FUND ALLOCATION.

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), and 11 N.N.C., Section 10, the Coppermine Chapter is duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Part 1, Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to the Title 26, NNC, Section 1 (B), The Coppermine Chapter is vested the governmental authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. Pursuant to the Navajo Nation Local Governance Act (LGA), 26 N.N.C. § 2003, all Navajo Nation Chapters are required to follow the Navajo Nation budget instructions when preparing and submitting a Chapter’s budget. Each Chapter shall submit a Chapter proposed budget, through a duly approved Chapter Resolution and in accordance with the approved budget calendar to the Administrative Service Center of the Division of Community Development (DCD). DCD shall incorporate and submit the budget as part of the overall annual DCD budget; and
4. The Navajo Nation Appropriations Act, 12 N.N.C. §§ 800 *et seq.*, is the primary Navajo Nation law which authorizes the process of developing and implementing the annual Navajo Nation comprehensive budget. The Appropriations Act states that the Navajo Nation government has a fiduciary responsibility to:
 - Account for public funds.
 - Manage finances wisely.
 - Plan for the adequate funding of services desired by the Navajo people, including the provision and maintenance of public facilities.
5. The Navajo Nation Government utilizes performance budgeting as a factor in making budget decisions. The Appropriations Act mandates a budget development process which includes the use of program performance information which is a method that incorporates the use of program performance criteria (goals and actual results) to assist with the allocation of funds during the budget development process.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED THAT:

The Coppermine Chapter hereby approves the FY 2021 General Fund Appropriation Funding by the Navajo Nation Council from the General Fund Revenue Projection Funding in the amount of Two Hundred sixty Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$260,173.00) Appropriation for FY 2021 Coppermine Chapter General Fund Allocation.
