- 5. Coppermine Chapter reviewed and assessed three proposals submitted by the deadline date and selected the electrical contractor that submitted the lowest bid and within the maximum allowable cost to perform the house wiring installation.

The Coppermine Chapter approves an electrical services contract with Gilbert Sons Electric to upgrade electrical house wiring for the Coppermine Chapter Scattered Powerline Project for the amount of \$17,808.00 budgeted from Acct. 23-6812 Infrastructure House wiring.
