RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER COPPERMINE, NAVAJO NATION, ARIZONA

AMENDING RESOLUTION CO11-06-17: SUPPORTING AND RECOMMENDING A LAND WITHDRAWAL AND BUSINESS SITE LEASE FOR 4 ACRES FOR ALLARICE MEEHAN ON LAND LOCATED IN COPPERMINE, ARIZONA TO OPERATE A BED AND BREAKFAST BUSINESS

Whereas:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(A), and 11 N.N.C., Section 10, the Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Part 1, Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1(b) Coppermine Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. The Coppermine Chapter has an obligation to promote the interest and welfare of the community residents which includes growth of local economic; and
4. The Coppermine Chapter wishes to promote future growth in the area which will the eventually create new income and job opportunities for the private and public sectors of the Navajo Nation economy; and
5. Allarice Meehan is requesting a land withdrawal and business site lease for four (4) acres and request support from Coppermine Chapter to formally operate a bed and breakfast business.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


1. The Coppermine Chapter hereby supports and recommends the land withdrawal and business site lease for four (4) acres for Allarice Meehan on land located in Coppermine, Arizona.
2. The Coppermine Chapter hereby supports and recognizes this land withdrawal for community development, which may include, but is not limited to, the following purposes; housing, education, economic development, healthcare facilities, public use, or governmental use. Industrial development is not supported for this area.
3. The Coppermine Chapter requests the proper offices of the Navajo Nation to do all things necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this resolution.




