- The Coppermine Chapter supported and approved Resolution CO-04-070-07 dated April 15, 2007, for the withdrawal of 75 acres' tract of land for the construction of a new health center north of Gap Primary School; and
- 4. The Coppermine Chapter acknowledged four (4) potential sites that were evaluated by Indian Health Service and community members in 2005. The primary site recommended north of Gap Primary School on NR-20 was determined to be most feasible that is easily accessible to nearby infrastructure (utilities, water, electricity and roads) for the New Health Facility; and
- The Coppermine Chapter still supports the proposal and acknowledges all favorable changes, and plans, and updates that have been made since the initial commitment to and hereby reaffirmed.
