ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 COPPERMINE CHAPTER CARRYOVER FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$693,345.79 AND INCORPORATE SAME INTO THE FY2017 COPPERMINE CHAPTER OPERATING BUDGET OF \$263,142 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$956,487.79 AS THE FY2017 OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C, Section 3 (A), and 11 N.N.C, Section 10, the Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C, Part 1, Section 10, and;
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 1 (B) Coppermine Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions, and;
3. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 1 (B) Coppermine Chapter is a governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo law, including custom and tradition; and
4. The Coppermine Chapter has FY 2016 carryover funds the Amount of \$693,345.79 that will be added to FY2017 Operating Budget of \$263,142.00 for a **TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$956,487.79 FY2017 Operating Budget** for Coppermine Chapter; and




