RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION

REQUESTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF DIVISION OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO APPROVE COPPERMINE CHAPTER'S REQUEST TO TEMPORARILY HIRE THE COMMUNITY SERVICES CORRDINATOR, WILFORD LANE AND ACCOUNTS MAINTENANCE SPECIALIST, ROYLENTIA BEGAY. EMPLOYMENT WILL BEGIN AUGUST 13, 2018 FOR A PERIOD OF SIX (6) MONTHS OR WHEN THE POSITION IS PERMANANTLY FILLED. THE HIRING OF TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES IS ACCORDING TO THE NAVAJO NATION PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3(a), Coppermine Chapter is a certified and recognized Chapter of the Navajo Nation Government as listed under II NNC Part 1, Section 10 and is further recognized as a local Tribal Government entity with the responsibility to act in the best interest and general welfare of the community; and
- 2. The Navajo Nation Council established the Health, Education, and Human Services ("HEHS") Committee as a standing committee with the purpose to oversee Navajo Nation efforts in implementing and ensuring compliance with the Navajo Nation employment and labor laws and policies. N.N.C. (3); and
- 3. The Navajo Nation gives preference in employment to enrolled members of the Navajo Nation in accordance with the provisions of the Navajo Preference in Employment Act (15 N.N.C. 601—619); and
- 4. The Executive Director of the Division of Human Resources and the Politically Appointed Division of Community Development Director, pertaining to Recruitment and Selection, jointly: a. may waive any policies under this Section if the essential program services are being hampered by critical employment needs for a specific class or classes provided that the waiver is not contrary to Navajo Nation law; b. may implement temporary procedures; and c. shall ensure that employees hired under temporary procedures are selected on the basis of the criteria herein; and
- 5. Temporary employees are those who are hired as interim replacements or to supplement the work force, or to assist in the completion of a specific project. Employment of a temporary to fill a vacant regular status position is limited to a maximum of six (6) consecutive months in a program's fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED THAT:

1. Requesting the Executive Director of the Division of Human Resources and the Division of Community Development Director to approve Coppermine Chapter's request to temporarily hire the Community Services Coordinator, Wilford Lane and Account Maintenance Specialist, Roylentia Begay. Employment will begin August 13, 2018 for a period of six (6) months or when the position is permanently filled. The hiring of temporary employees is according to the Navajo Nation Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual.
