Land withdrawal starts the process. Today we just need the CLUP resolution signed. Need the consent from livestock permit holder too. Need that permission to be on the land.

Edbert – indicate on the resolution its not for industrial development but commercial. Many applications are lacking arch clearances, biological, legal descriptions, etc. council delegate may put more restrictions on the economic development which now the long process, need to have funds to start business, who is going to start businesses, who is going to build homes, who is going to move into the homes, etc. this is why many projects are just there with no development due to funds.
