2. Chapter President – Allen Fowler Jr.: ARPA Funds are still being discussed by Legislative and Executive Branches. First windmill drilling has been completed and they will move to Second Windmill. We are still getting price quotes for heavy-duty trailer. Western Agency declared Special election for Chapter Secretary/treasurer. Opening dates are from February 7 -21 th.for filing for the position.

Question from Laverne: When was this opened? There's not enough time given for this. This is all up to Navajo Election Administration: 1-888-508-4970 or 928-283-3220. Laverne: Second windmill drilling has been completed. Will we get documentation of who and how much hay will be given to each person?

The grazing official will address that in his report.

- 3. Chapter Vice-President Lola Smith: We had an updated Gap-Bodaway Health Clinic Steering Committee Meeting on Feb. 16. We met virtually with Glen Tsingine, head Engineer Candance Tsingine, DFME, G. Notah, R Tso, all of IHS. Also on call were TCRHCC Admin Staff and Board Members. At this time, all documents have been submitted to Headquarters for further review and amendments. Also, if this clinic will be compacted (638), President Nez has the final authority.
- 4. Chapter Grazing Official Stanford Fowler: Individual permit holders who had 2021 tally Counts and have submitted AIF application are eligible to receive hay. Presently, there are about 95 applicants that have applied for the AIF funds/hay. In 2021, there were 123 tally counts out of 188 permit holders. 34 grazing permits are in non-used status. 29 permits are in need of probate status. Out of \$31,610.48 AIF fund, some will cover freight and hay

expenses. With a rough estimate, it may come to 13 to 15 bales per permittee. I will be looking for quality hay.

5. CLUPC – Linda Long: Concerning the CLUP manual, Mr. Davis of ASU, said he wanted three other individuals to proofread it. Another item, I understand that the room rental fee at Twin Arrows has not been paid. Mr. A. Fowler: I will follow up on that.
