



WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3, and 11 N.N.C., Section 10 the Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized and certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., Part 1, Section 10;
2. The Coppermine Chapter is vested to improve the general welfare of community members by providing and assisting them with opportunity for improvements in the areas of livelihood, health, education; and
3. The Coppermine Chapter is given the authority to secure any economic and social opportunity that is in the nest of Coppermine Chapter and community; and
4. Coppermine Chapter is supporting and recommending the land withdrawal of 1 (one) acre for commercial and economic purposes, mainly a Multipurpose and Senior Citizen building, on Coppermine Chapter compound.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Coppermine Chapter hereby supports and approves the land withdrawal of 1 (one) acre for commercial and economic purpose, mainly a Multipurpose and Senior Citizen Building, within the vicinity of the Coppermine Chapter compound.

The Coppermine Chapter hereby supports and recognizes this land withdrawal designation for community development which may include, but is not limited to, the following purpose: housing, education, economic development, healthcare facilities, public use, or governmental use. Industrial development is not supported in this area. The land withdrawal designation is for 1 (one) are within the vicinity of Coppermine community.
3. The Coppermine Chapter requests the proper offices of the Navajo Nation and Bureau of Indian Affairs to do all things necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this resolution.
